## Requirements to be considered:

- Must be WIA eligible
- High school diploma preferred **but not required**
- 18 years or older

## WHAT TO EXPECT

### Week One - March 24 - 26 – Paperwork and Work Readiness Training at JOBLEaders

- Wednesday, March 24<sup>th</sup> - Paperwork with Proteam Staffing from 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.
- Thursday and Friday, March 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> - Two days of Work Readiness Training from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor at JOBLEaders.

### Week Two - March 29 - April 2 - Painter Training

- **Two Days** – Classroom sessions on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor at JOBLEaders
  - Monday from 8:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.
  - Tuesday from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.\* **\*Trainees will take an EPA test that they must pass at 70% or greater to proceed with the remaining training.**

#### Classroom Curriculum Includes:

Paint Basics, Paint Application and Applicators, Paint Troubleshooting, Safety, EPA, Renovation, Repair and Painting (RRP) Training & Certification.

- **Three Days** – Hands on painting on site – Transportation provided from JOBLEaders
  - Wednesday – Thursday from 8:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Arrive at 8:00 a.m. to catch the shuttle to the work site. Return at 3:30 p.m.
  - Friday – 8:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. **Graduation Day!** No return shuttle service. Please make arrangements. You will have a supply of painting equipment provided by Sherwin Williams to transport home with you.

#### Hands-on Applications Include:

Observe and practice correct application technique,  
Practice correct application technique on-the-job. Learn proper surface preparation.  
All hands on training will be performed at an Antrim Park shelter house.

## VERY IMPORTANT!

**Trainees must attend both days of Work Readiness and all 5 days of Painter training to graduate. If any day is missed, trainee will be dropped from class.**
